



2020 GIRLS' GRAMMAR UNIFORM CODE

School Uniform Code

All items of the School uniform must be clean, fit correctly and be clearly named. The School dress must be worn to sit just below the knee. Students with a shorter uniform will be asked to rectify the length. Polished, standard, black leather, lace-up shoes are to be worn, with the laces laced at the top, outside of the shoe.

Students must wear full formal School uniform when travelling to and from school, especially when travelling by public transport. All uniform rules apply during exam blocks.

What to Wear

Summer Uniform:

- IGGS tartan dress
- White, sky or navy tie
- IGGS navy hat
- White socks
- Plain black, traditional-style leather lace-up shoes with 2-3cm heels (polished regularly)
- IGGS bag
- School and House badges

Winter Uniform:

- IGGS tartan dress (with tie)
- IGGS School blazer
- Navy stockings and plain black school shoes
- IGGS navy pullover or vest
- IGGS bag
- IGGS navy hat
- School and House badges

Sports Uniform:

- IGGS sky polo
- IGGS navy shorts
- White sports shoes with non-marking soles and IGGS sports socks
- IGGS sports cap or bucket hat
- IGGS swimming togs and sky swim cap
- IGGS sports bags. No other type of bag is permitted. Sports bags must only be used for sports gear.

In addition to compulsory uniform items, the Uniform Shop also sells non-compulsory items such as hair accessories and special items for co-curricular activities. Students must only wear the School-approved uniform including accessories. Please speak with the Uniform Shop staff to confirm the correct requirements and sizes for your daughters. Prices are correct as at November 2019, and are subject to change.

All items on the uniform list, except school shoes and sports shoes, are available at the Uniform Shop, with some second-hand items available from the Cottage Shop.

How to Wear your IGGS Uniform

Students must wear full School uniform to school every day. All uniform items should be clean and in good repair.

Full uniform, including hat, is to be worn when wearing the uniform in public before and after school, e.g. at shopping centres (no joggers, thongs, hair down, etc).

A navy head scarf may be worn for religious purposes.

Badges

The School badge is worn on the lower part of the left collar (over the heart). The House badge is worn on the lower part of the right collar.

All leadership badges are worn above the School badge, including Prefect, House and Co-Curricular Captain badges.

Boarder badges are worn above the House badge (right collar).

The Senior badge is pinned on the middle of the navy tie.

Membership/participation badges are to be worn on the right collar above the House badge and only for the duration of the activity.

Charity badges are only to be worn for the duration of the School's campaign, and must be worn on the right-hand collar.

No badges to be worn on blazer lapels.

Bags

Students must carry IGGs school and sports bags to school, sporting fixtures and training. No other type of bag is permitted.

Blazer

The School blazer is worn by all students in Years 7 to 12 during the winter months and on formal occasions (e.g. representing the School at events). The collar of the dress is to be worn inside the lapels when wearing the blazer. The blazer must be worn when wearing a jumper over the dress outside the School grounds.

Collars

Collars are to be worn 'out' when wearing jumpers. Collars are to be worn 'in' with the blazer.

Dress

Length must be 10cm below the knee and kept in good repair.

Hair

Hair longer than collar length must be neatly tied back with hair bands and navy, pale blue or white ribbons (1cm wide), or School tartan scrunchies and plain navy clips. Checked, striped, gauzy, spotted or other-shade-of-blue ribbons are not permitted.

Long fringes should be pinned back. All side pieces should be pinned back. Hair should be its natural colour.

Hat

The School hat must be worn at all times when travelling to and from school each day, when students are attending excursions or school activities, and during recess and lunch breaks, including when ordering from the canteen.

It should be worn at all times when wearing the uniform in public, including in shopping malls, in shopping centres, and in shops.

Hats should be labelled, with the student's name on the inside band. No names or graffiti are allowed on the underside of the hat brim.

Jewellery

The only jewellery permitted is a Medi-Alert bracelet, a plain, discreet watch (with plain silver, gold or dark leather band e.g. navy, black or brown) and one pair only of small (3-6mm), plain gold, silver or pearl studs or sleepers in the ear lobes. Sparkly stones and decorative earrings are not permitted.

No rings or bracelets (except approved medi-alert bracelets).

A religious necklace may be worn, but must be under the uniform and out of sight.

Any form of tongue, facial or body piercing jewellery is not allowed, including clear/flesh-coloured studs.

Jumper

The School jumper is not to be worn without the blazer in summer or winter months when travelling to or from school.

Make-up

Make-up is not permitted at school - this includes lip gloss, eye shadow, eye liner, mascara, eyebrow pencil/dye, foundation and blusher. Students will be asked to remove it. Lip balm is permitted. Fake tans are also not permitted. Permission will be granted for the IGGs and other Year 12 Formals.

Finger nails with a french polish, colour or false nails are not permitted at school. Students will be asked to remove these.

School Shoes

School shoes must be plain, standard black leather lace-up shoes in the traditional style, with 1-2cm heels, and polished regularly. No deck shoes, ballet styles, boots or mary-janes (strap across the instep) are permitted.

Socks

White crew socks are to be worn up the leg with the summer uniform. Ankle socks are not permitted.

Navy stockings are worn in winter by all students.

Sports Uniform

Must be worn for PE and sports training. It is not to be worn to and from School unless special permission is given. School sports cap must be worn when participating in outdoor PE classes and sports.

Tie

The School tie is worn 'outside' when wearing the School jumper. No badges, except the Senior badge are to be pinned on the tie. Students in various year levels wear different coloured ties as follows:

- White – Years 7 to 9
- Pale Blue – Years 10 and 11
- Navy – Year 12
