

SMART CARD – IGGS/IGS BUS PASS

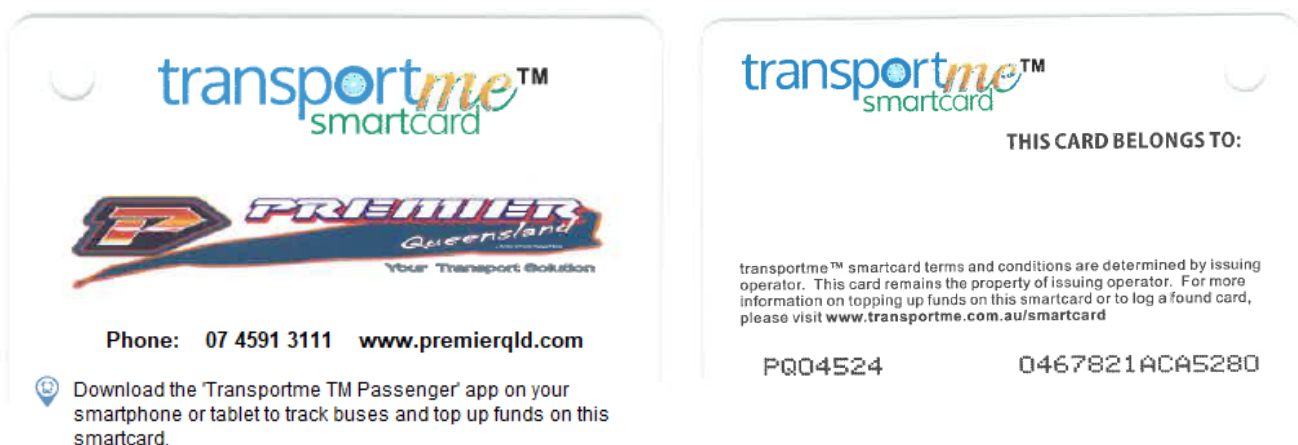
From the commencement of each school year your child/children will be issued with the Transport Me Smart Card for use when entering and exiting the School's charter bus services.

- Every child at Ipswich Girls' and Junior Grammar School and Ipswich Grammar School who uses the Premier QLD's school bus service will receive a Smart Card which will become their bus pass for the year.
- They will tap their card as they board and disembark the bus in the mornings and afternoons
- It is crucial that the student brings their bus pass each day and follows the above process
- The Schools and Premier QLD will be monitoring the card usage and the Schools will be checking this against the billing documentation they have on file
Please note the billing of the bus service will remain with the School and the current system with only a half or full pass option available
- Student behavior will also be monitored by this system in conjunction with onboard cameras on selected routes

The Smart Cards will be handed out by the Schools in the first week of Term 1, if you are wanting your child to travel please make sure that you have the information to the Schools to allow the smartcards to be assigned and issued in the first week.

Lost passes will incur a cost of \$15 to be replaced.

The smartcard looks exactly like the example below, your child's name will be written on the back.
