Tuition and boarding fees are charged by the term. There are four (4) terms per year. *The payment of all school fees is required by the due date (first day of each term).*

- Term 1 fees payable by 23 January 2023 (early payment discount date is 16 January)
- Term 2 fees payable by 17 April 2023 (early payment discount date is 10 April)
- Term 3 fees payable by 10 July 2023 (early payment discount date is 03 July)
- Term 4 fees payable by 3 October 2023 (early payment discount date is 26 September)

Payment can be made by cash, EFTPOS, Direct Deposit or via Parent Lounge. Credit card payments made via Parent Lounge are free of surcharge. Credit card surcharge applies for all other credit card payments.

A discount of \$60 per term on both tuition and boarding fees will apply if payment is received by 3.30pm one week prior to the due date. Early payment discount dates are outlined above.

### SIBLING DISCOUNT

The Board of Trustees has approved the following discounts on tuition fees:

- For the second student from one family attending the School concurrently, 5%
- For third and subsequent students from one family attending the School concurrently, 10%
- Where a family has boys at IGS and girls at IGGS concurrently, 3.5%

### EDSTART AND FUTURITY

Edstart allows parents to spread out the school fee costs, either over 12 months or up to five years after graduation, lowering your monthly repayments. You can find out more about Edstart by visiting their website at <https://edstart.com.au/iggs>.

### LATE PAYMENT FEE

Where accounts are not paid by the due date, a late payment administration fee of \$120 per term will be charged. Allowance should be made for external agencies' processing time. Approved payment arrangements that are in place to pay accounts by the end of each term will avoid the late payment fee, provided there is no default in the terms of the arrangement. Where accounts are referred to a collection agency, the agency costs will be added to the amount outstanding (refer to Fees Payment Policy).

### BOARD OF TRUSTEES - FEE PAYMENT POLICY

Payment of all fees by the due date is a condition of continued attendance at the School and the provision of education services. Failure to pay fees as and when due, may lead to the withdrawal of education services and the removal of the student from the School. The School also reserves the right to withhold student report cards and/or statements of reference if accounts remain overdue at the end of the term/semester.

Where fees are not paid by the due date, payment arrangements are available, however, such payments can only be made by direct bank debit authority. No other payment arrangements are acceptable.

### CAPITAL LEVY (non-tax deductible)

A compulsory capital levy of \$75 per family per term is included on each term's fees account. This levy will directly support the capital works program of the School.

### VOLUNTARY BUILDING FUND (tax deductible)

A building fund donation of \$50 or more can be made to the School. This contribution to the building fund enables voting rights in a single cycle of the Board of Trustees reconstitution. Current cycle April 2021 - April 2025.

## ITEMS NOT INCLUDED IN THE TUITION FEES

Additional fees are payable on a user-pays basis for some activities. These fees are payable via Parent Lounge which is accessible via the School's website. Fees will be charged to an account at the end of each Term and are due for payment on the due date for tuition fees. **Note that EEC fees are billed separately.**

Via website (Parent Lounge):

- Co-curricular activities
- Camps
- Excursions and visitor activities (any excess not covered by tuition fee)
- Hospitality Levy, Years 10 to 12
- Fees for special programs
- Non QGSSSA/Andrews Cup/Britton Shield sports participation and travel

Charged to account:

- Chartered bus fares to and from school and for special events
- Instrumental Program, \$30 per year levied in Term 1 for Years 3 to 5; Instrumental Hire Scheme is available
- Textbook Hire Scheme for Years 7 to 12
- Non-Queensland Resident Textbook Levy
- Other incidental costs incurred by the School

Other items:

- Excess printing and photocopying charges (i.e. over and above the allocations of \$20 per year for Prep to Year 3, \$60 per year for Years 4 to 12, except Graphics students at \$100 per year)
- Private lessons for singing, music, tennis (invoiced directly by tutor)

Expenditure incurred by boarders such as personal items, telephone, medical, travel and some excursions will be charged to boarders' accounts or by agreement with parents. A boarder activity levy of \$750 per annum for full-time boarders will be charged by semester; Semester 1 - \$500 and Semester 2 - \$250. The levy covers a camp, additional weekend activities and excursions. Weekly boarders will incur a \$50 per semester activity levy.

## STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE

The School pays the premium for student insurance through AON Australia. The current brochure is available on request which details items covered by the policy. Enrolled students are covered for the year.

## ENROLMENT APPLICATION FEE

All applications for entry into the School incur a \$110 (including GST) application fee which covers processing costs. This fee is non-refundable and does not guarantee a place in the School.

## CONFIRMATION FEE

Acceptance of the offer of a place in the School must be accompanied by a confirmation fee: \$500 for girls in Prep to Year 12, and \$250 for boys in Prep to Year 6. The confirmation fee is non-refundable.

### **NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL (DOMESTIC & INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS)**

The School commits resources based on confirmed enrolments. Once a student has been enrolled in the School, it is essential that parents/guardians provide **one full term's notice** if they are intending to withdraw a student from the school. If a parent/guardian is intending to withdraw a student, then a full term's notice must be sent in writing to the Principal. Failure to do so will result in a full term's tuition fees being charged in lieu of this notice.

*Where a student is withdrawing at the end of each current term, written withdrawal is required at the beginning of that term to avoid being charged for the next term's tuition fees. The required dates are as follows:*

- *Withdrawal at the end of Term 1 2023 will need to be received by 23 January 2023.*
- *Withdrawal at the end of Term 2 2023 - by 17 April 2023; and*
- *Withdrawal at the end of Term 3 2023 - by 10 July 2023,*

For all students not returning in 2024 - Term 4 Withdrawal:

- *written notice of withdrawal is required by 31 October 2023 otherwise one half-term's fees will be payable for 2024, 1 November 2023 up to 31 December 2023.*

**• WHEN WITHDRAWAL NOTICE IS RECEIVED AFTER 1 JANUARY 2024 FOR STUDENTS NOT RETURNING, ONE (1) FULL TERM'S TUITION FEES WILL BE PAYABLE.**
