**Weekly Boarding** is charged at **\$4725 per term** on top of the Tuition, Annual IT Levy, Capital Levy and Activity Levy listed above.

### Other Fees and Charges

**Enrolment Application Fee** (non-refundable) \$110 on application for admission. This fee does not guarantee a place in the School.

**Enrolment Confirmation Fee** (non-refundable) \$500 payable within 14 days of receiving notification of placement offer.

Some **additional student expenses** may need to be charged if incurred. These include non-curriculum related expenses and boarders' medical expenses.

**Chartered Bus Fares** are charged on fee accounts each Term. The cost of these buses varies depending which bus the student catches. Costs may be charged on a pro-rata basis (ie: change of address).

### Discounts

**Sibling Discount** – The Board of Trustees has approved the following discounts on tuition fees:

- For the second student from one family attending the School concurrently, 5%
- For third and subsequent students from one family attending the School concurrently, 10%
- Where a family has boys at IGS and girls at IGGs concurrently, 3.5%

**Early Payment Discount** – A discount of \$60 per term on both tuition and boarding fees will apply if payment is received by 3.30pm one week prior to the due date and a 5% discount per year will apply if the years fees are paid by the Term 1 due date.

## Fee Payment Dates

**Tuition and boarding fees are charged by the term. There are four (4) terms per year. The payment of all school fees is required by the due date (first day of each term).**

- Term 1 fees payable by 22 January 2024 (early payment discount date is 15 January)
- Term 2 fees payable by 15 April 2024 (early payment discount date is 8 April)
- Term 3 fees payable by 9 July 2024 (early payment discount date is 2 July)
- Term 4 fees payable by 30 September 2024 (early payment discount date is 23 September)

**Payment can be made by cash, EFTPOS, Direct Deposit or via Parent Lounge. Credit card payments made via Parent Lounge are free of surcharge. Credit card surcharge applies for all other credit card payments.**

## Voluntary Building Fund (tax deductible)

A building fund donation of \$50 or more can be made to the School. This contribution to the building fund enables voting rights in a single cycle of the Board of Trustees reconstitution. Current cycle April 2021 – April 2025.

## Withdrawal

The School commits resources based on confirmed enrolments. Once a student has been enrolled in the School, it is essential that parents/carers provide one full term's notice if they are intending to withdraw a student from the school. This should be done using our online withdrawal application form – [iggs.qld.edu.au/enrol/withdrawal-of-enrolment](https://iggs.qld.edu.au/enrol/withdrawal-of-enrolment). Failure to do so will result in one full term's tuition fees being charged in lieu of this notice.

## Living Away From Home Allowance

The Department of Education provides financial assistance to eligible Queensland families, who do not have reasonable daily access to a Queensland Government school with the relevant school year level.

Student must be boarding away from home and be attending an approved boarding school with the required school year levels.

In 2024, families with students in Years 7 to 12 can claim up to a total maximum of \$10,276 per year.

## Board of Trustees – Fee Payment Policy

Payment of all fees by the due date is a condition of continued attendance at the School and the provision of education services. Failure to pay fees as and when due, may lead to the withdrawal of education services and the removal of the student from the School. The School also reserves the right to withhold student report cards and/or statements of reference if accounts remain overdue at the end of the term/semester.

Where fees are not paid by the due date, payment arrangements are available, however, such payments can only be made by direct bank debit authority. No other payment arrangements are acceptable.
